Dear Chairman Kurtz:

The above-referenced project site is an undeveloped I-2 zoned property located on the south and east side of the intersection of Route 10 and Fieldstone Court in Cheshire, Connecticut. The site contains wetland soils along the southern boundary of the property that were field located by a certified soil scientist. The proposed activities for the Earth Removal, Filling, or Regrading Permit include clearing and grubbing existing trees outside of the 50-foot upland review area and site grading to place available fill material. Sediment and erosion control measures have been designed to prevent adverse impacts to the town's drainage system and wetlands on and off site. The plan does not include any disturbance to the wetland areas nor propose any activity within the 50-foot regulated upland review area.

At this time, we are requesting a determination for the need of an Inland Wetlands and Watercourses permit for this project.
