**REQUEST FOR DETERMINATION**  
**BROAD BROOK / MIDDLE EAST SELECTIVE TIMBER HARVEST**  
**CUTTING SCHEDULE / SEDIMENTATION AND EROSION CONTROL PLAN**

Scotland Hardwoods (A Rossi Company) plans to conduct a logging operation on approximately 60 of 380.7 total acres owned by the City Of Meriden. About half of the area is located in the Town of Wallingford. It is important to note that all of the main skid trails, yarding areas and drainage crossings are already established due to previous timber harvests that have been conducted. The last one involved with this area was done about 18 years ago. This land is further identified by the Cheshire Assessors Map #61 and Lot #9. A one to three man logging crew operating a log skidder will cut and skid the logs to three main yarding areas two of which are located in Wallingford. One is off Reservoir Road and the other two are located on the Eversource power line right of way which entry and exit point is off Route #68. From these yarding areas a tri-axle log truck will pick up the logs and exit the property via Route #68 and Reservoir Road. Regular working hours are from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM Monday thru Saturday. The property boundaries have been marked with fluorescent pink flagging and the main skid roads have been identified with blue. Before the project starts all of the trees to be harvested will be marked with orange paint about 4 feet above the ground and at the base of each stump. It is estimated that about sixty to seventy thousand board feet of sawtimber will be harvested from the property. Concerning the harvest area approximately 90% of the White Ash trees will be removed as most of these trees are dead or dying due an insect called the Emerald Ash Borer. Of the remaining trees, about 40% of these 14 inches D.B.H. (diameter at breast height) and larger, will be removed. Oak, White Ash, Black Birch, Maple, Hickory and Black Cherry represent the species of trees involved with the harvest. Any portion of the tops, concerning the harvested trees, not removed from the property will be reduced to within five feet of the ground level. It is estimated that about five to six weeks will be required to complete the project. We hope to start the harvest during the winter of 2021.

Four drainages will have to be crossed, two of which are located in Wallingford, concerning this project. It is planned to use portable bridges, in combination with wood poles and or a brush mat, concerning these areas. Upon completion of the harvest the main skid trails will be back bladed level and water bars will be installed where necessary. For further details concerning this activity please refer to Exhibit "B".



#### LEGEND

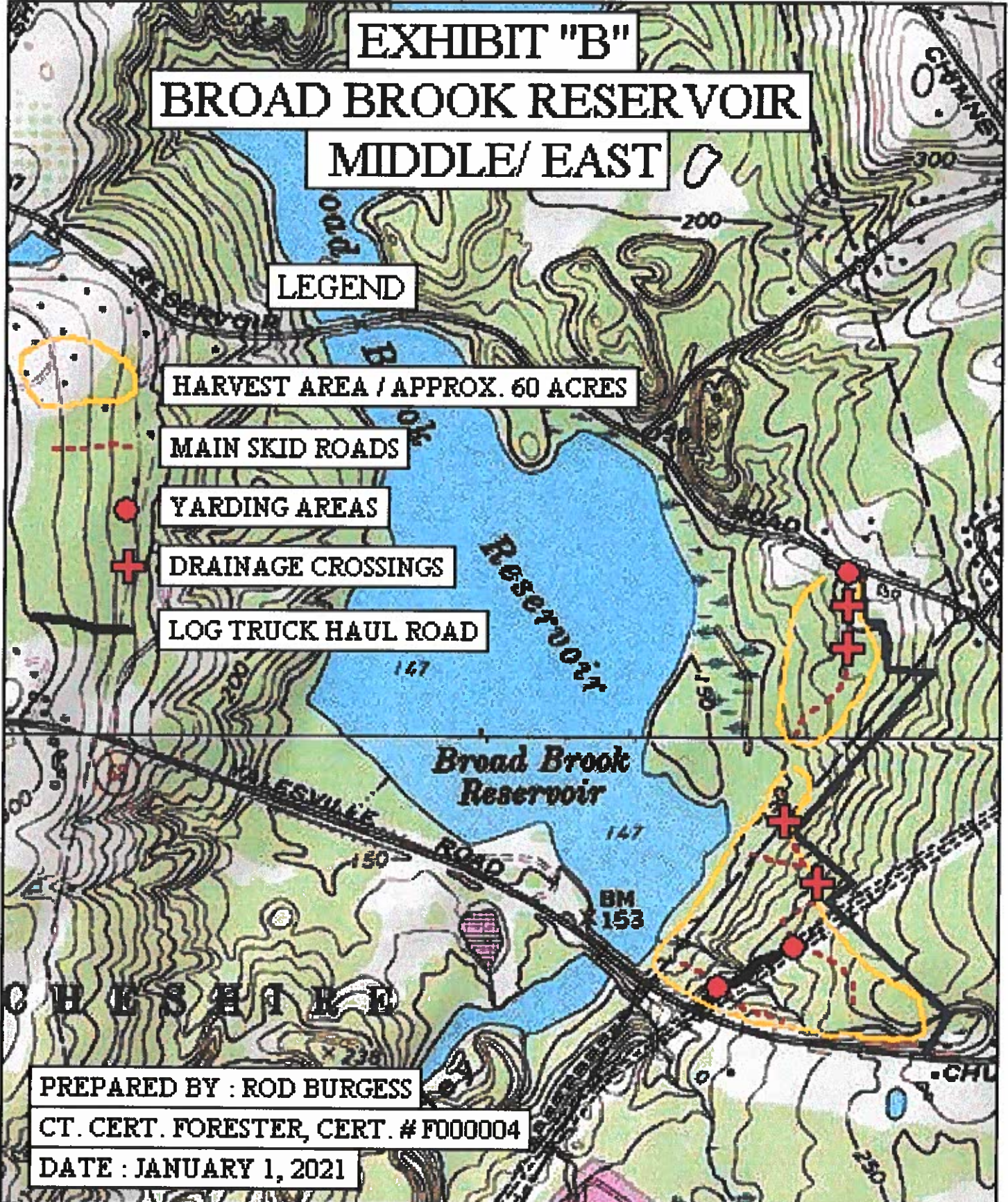
